RULES FOR EXHIBITORS OF MOTOR VEHICLES AT THE SCOCC GEORGE OLD CAR SHOW 2025 8 February 2025

1. The theme for the 2025 George Old Car Show is "British Marque cars" and a special exhibition featuring "Rolls-Royces & Bentleys" will be showcased at the 2025 event.
2. All exhibitor cars must be pre-registered using the on-line registration form on the website www.scocc.co.za. Only cars that have been pre-registered and approved will be granted access to the event. Registration closes on 26 January 2025.
3. Vehicles newer than 1980 will be approved at the discretion of the GOCS committee. Cars that have not been registered before 26 January 2025 and arrive at the gate on the day of the show, will be turned away.
4. Exhibitors will be provided with two complimentary wrist tags for access to the event. These wrist tags must be securely fastened around the wrists of the driver and passenger and worn at all times during the show. They are waterproof and should not be removed. Individuals without a wrist tag will be required to pay entrance fees or leave the premises.
5. Additional occupants of a vehicle can purchase entrance tickets on-line at iTickets or at the entrance gate.
6. There is no fee for exhibiting classic vehicles (excluding new vehicle exhibitors).
7. All vehicles must enter showground via Gate A. Check SMS prior to show for allocated parking, re Field X and Parking bay X.
8. Exhibitors will be directed to the appropriate parking areas in the exhibition zone by field marshals.
9. All vehicles must be parked in their designated spaces by 08:00 on Saturday. Vehicles can be parked from 12:00 on Friday afternoon. Ideally, all vehicles should remain until 18:00 on Saturday (exceptions can be made upon request).
10. Gates will open on Friday from 12:00 to 18:00 for early parking. On Saturday, gates open at 06:00, but it is essential to park your vehicle before 08:00 sharp. (Exceptions can be made by prior arrangement.) Latecomers cannot be guaranteed parking in allocated areas, even if registered beforehand. Overflow parking will be directed to a designated common exhibition area.
11. Vehicles may be left overnight; many people do leave their vehicles overnight, and security will be provided on Friday and Saturday nights. **However, the Southern Cape Old Car Club, the Eden Technical High School,**

their agents, members, and organizers do not assume any liability or responsibility for loss, damage, or injury to any vehicle or individual for any reason.

12. Exhibitors who have registered in advance should collect their exhibitor's certificates at the Registration/INFO tent. If you have already registered, please do not fill in another registration form. No exhibitor's certificates will be printed during the show.
13. Tow-cars and service vehicles are prohibited from parking in the exhibition area and are not allowed in the exhibition area after 08:00 on Saturday and before 18:00 on Saturday. They should be relocated to the public parking area at Carpe Diem School, where ample space is available.
14. Trailers can be parked in the designated trailer park.
15. Driving within the exhibition area is only allowed when instructed by a Marshall or for participating in a drive-by display.
16. All vehicles must be equipped with a fully functional fire extinguisher and possess a valid inspection certificate. Random inspections will be conducted by the Fire Department.
17. Open fires or barbecues of any kind are not permitted on the show grounds. Please support the food stalls available.
18. Camping or overnight sleeping is not permitted in the exhibition area. Accommodation is available at the school hostels or nearby facilities (refer to our website, www.scooc.co.za , for more information).
19. Bringing alcohol onto the school grounds is prohibited. A bar is available on the premises.
20. Loud music or excessive engine revving is not permitted in the exhibition area.
21. Photographic material taken at the event may only be used for personal purposes and requires written permission from the Southern Cape Old Car Club committee for any other use.
22. Sales of any kind from car boots are strictly prohibited. However, dedicated Exhibition Stalls are available for sellers in various categories. Additionally, there is a designated area for a "swop meet," which is not staffed.
23. Displaying "FOR SALE" signs on motor vehicles are not allowed.
24. **PLEASE TAKE NOTE:** All access gates, including pedestrian gates, to the exhibition area will be locked promptly at 18:00 on Friday and 19:00 on Saturday evenings. After 19:00, no vehicles will be permitted to exit through the gates. No exceptions will be made.
